Cassit Bird Mating Rules



Birds are monogamous (they stay with the same mate)

Birds produce TWO offspring per year

Mating Directions:

1. Find a mate. Place your sex cells upside down in two piles (one for the male (sperm) and one for the female(eggs)).

2. Randomly draw one egg and one sperm.

4. Determine what your offspring looks like by completing the **Our Offspring** sheet.

5. Return the egg and sperm to the respective piles, shuffle, and randomly draw one more egg and sperm to create your second offspring.
